Note	<p>1. To attain graduation eligibility, undergraduate students admitted in the 2012-12 academic year and beyond must meet the graduation requirements specified in these procedures and the enforcement rules for Service-Learning, English proficiency, Information Technology proficiency, Chinese proficiency and Sports capability, as well as the professional competencies stated in these regulations. (1) Students are required to meet the professional competencies outlined below during their period of study: Students must complete and pass their graduation project through teamwork. (2) Students are required to complete 400 internship hours on or off campus. Furthermore, they need to write internship reports and pass the requirements of employers and the department. (3) Students must acquire at least one professional certificate in the leisure and recreation field. These include (but are not limited to) Tour leader and Tour guide certifications (Mandarin & English), certificates in cookery and hospitality, coaching/referee license, or CPR license, etc. (4) Student must plan and execute a leisure activity programming project. They are also required to submit and pass the review of the project proposal and final report. Beginning with those enrolling in the academic year of 2012, students are required to take at least 12 credit hours of General Education courses. There are three disciplines within General Education — Humanities, Social Science and Natural Science. The courses are categorized into “Core Course” and “Extended Courses” under each discipline. To meet the graduation requirements, students are required to take at least one 2- credit-hour course in each category of each of the disciplines.</p> <p>2. Each department at least choose 26 credit scores and need to elect each own department course. If department chairman agree to choose other department courses in school of tourism and tourism course in International College, at most 15 credit scores are included in graduation credit scores.</p> <p>3. Surpass General education course, education course are not included in graduation credit courses.</p> <p>4. The elective courses on this Course Outline may be counted toward total graduation credits by students who entered the university prior to the 2012-12 academic year</p> <p>5. Professional required scores of Freshman and Sophomore at least 47 credit scores, at most 50 credit scores.</p>
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
